- Monitor progress closely, set personalised targets for future learning and keep parents informed through termly parent/carer/teacher meetings.
- Work in partnership with families, contacting parents promptly if there are concerns about attendance or punctuality.

Parents/Carers

Together with Parkfield Primary School, we will:

- Support regular school attendance and avoid term-time holidays where possible, recognising the importance of consistency in learning.

- Ensure our/my child wears the correct school uniform and sensible footwear, helping them feel part of the school community and ready to learn.
