Summer Term 1

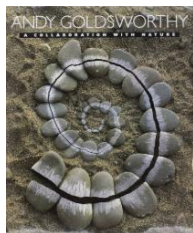
Please complete a minimum of two tasks and bring your work into school or send photographs of your work to your class email before the final week of the half term.

Using dice play and doubling game. Every time you roll the dice, double it! Can you write the doubles you find as



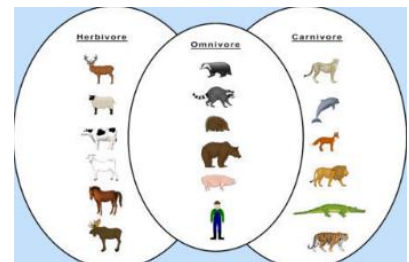
Online Safety:
