It is important to stay healthy and safe when we are online. Talk to your trusted adults to set screen time limits and discuss what it means to "stay safe."



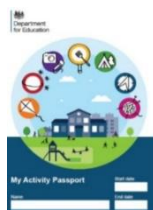
Topic:
