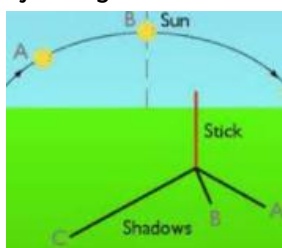

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MATHS/SCIENCE

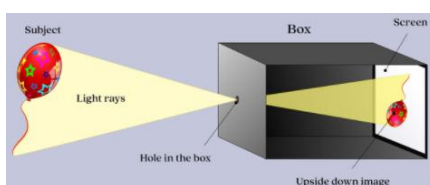
Place a pole or object in a sunny place. Measure the length of the shadow on the ground every hour for 6-8 hours. Record your findings in a table.

Design a pair of sunglasses or a hat which will keep you safe from the sun's harmful rays.

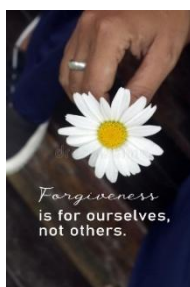
Explain why it is important to protect yourself from the sun.
